- Provide supplemental supports in EOC courses – review packets, one-on-one tutoring – to ensure academic preparedness for EOC Assessments.
- Provide wrap around supports such as mentors, career specialists, graduation coaches and community partners
- Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Feedback will be provided through written and verbal communication from teachers, mentors, and additional staff members. Conferences may be scheduled by parents, staff and/or students to discuss student progress.
- Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's education. Parents may contact the site director to arrange to volunteer, participate, and/or observe classroom activities.

Parent Responsibilities:

I/We, as a parent(s) will:

- Talk with my child about his/her attendance and academic progress and provide encouragement for him/her to stay on track for graduation.
- Make sure my child completes review packets and participates in one-on-one tutoring to ensure academic preparedness for the EOC assessments.
- Encourage my child to take full advantage of the wrap around supports offered at Foothills – mentors, career specialists, graduation coaches, community partners
- Maintain contact with the Foothills staff on my child's academic progress at the Foothills site he/she attends.
- Attend parent involvement activities to gain information on the instructional programs, to support my child's academic activities and to work with the staff on helping my child meet his/her graduation requirements.

Student Responsibilities:

I, as a student, will:

- Attend classes on a regular basis in order to continue to make progress in my courses.
- Meet with my mentor to ensure adequate pacing in courses and set goals to stay on track for graduation.
- Complete all review packets and participate in one-on-one tutoring to ensure academic preparedness for EOC Assessments.
- Take full advantage of the wrap around supports offered at Foothills – mentors, career specialists, graduation coaches, community partners
